## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

We are deep in the Christmas season and preparing for a new calendar year. We have celebrated Christmas day in some fashion. It was probably not like any other before. And now the New Year is approaching. The world will most likely breathe a sigh of relief once 2020 comes to a close.

The Christmas season addresses the heartache and despair that many feel. In the northern hemisphere, it is a dark, cold, brooding time. We look to a time of light, life and warmth. This is not just reflective of our physical being, but our emotional and spiritual needs. Many Christmas hymns touch on this tension of light and darkness, of despair and salvation. The first verse of "O Holy Night" juxtaposes a broken world desiring wholeness and the Messiah who brings it:

A thrill of hope the weary world rejoices For yonder breaks a new and glorious morn Fall on your knees; O hear the Angel voices! O night divine, O night when Christ was born O night, O Holy night, O night divine!

"It Came Upon a Midnight Clear" tells of the angelic chorus coming to the shepherds on those hills outside of Bethlehem. The angels come "with Good News of great joy...that the Messiah is born". The shepherds stand in for all humanity as they welcome this new-born king. The shepherds were part of a world that needed saving. We know that world all too well.


