

#### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

The readings used in worship the past several weeks have been from the prophets. They have called the people back to a place of faithfulness before judgement is meted out and then to a place of hope as they endured exile. The Babylonians attacked and leveled Jerusalem and the Temple. They also returned to Babylon with many Israelites as exiles. During the time in that foreign land, many renewed their efforts to be mindful of the covenant God had with them.

Generation after generation living in exile was far from easy, but the Israelites looked forward to the time when they would return to the Promised Land. God remained faithful to the covenant and cared for the people during that time. King Darius of Persia defeated the Babylonians and allowed the Israelites to go back to Jerusalem and rebuild the Temple and their lives. The time of re-building and re-constituting were not easy, but the Israelites endeavored to remember they were the people of God.

This sets a tone through out the season of Lent. The season is forty days long (not counting Sundays). It culminates with Holy Week and the crucifixion which leads to the Easter celebration. Lent is a time to reflect upon the human condition and make confession. These are days to consider God's on-going presence with us and the love that is shared through Jesus Christ. This love leads to sacrifice. Lent is a time to recognize we are strangers in a foreign land. Maybe not by borders, language or culture, but by faith and living a holy life. Living that sanctified life is only possible through presence and love of Jesus.

As God remained faithful to the Israelites in exile and their return, God is present with us during all our less than easy days. Lent and its disciplines (fasting, prayer and giving to the poor) encourage us to recognize that our reliance is truly upon God rather than ourselves. Use these days ahead to reflect upon your life, God's presence in it and where perhaps God is calling you.

**New Business**—The special congregational meeting on Sunday, March 30th after church will be to update the congregation on the roof fund and decide on a vendor to begin.


Motion to adjourn by John. Seconded by Sam.
