#### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Planting time is upon us. Farmers are working in the fields. Gardeners are prepping their plots. Neighborhoods are abuzz with the sounds of lawn mowers. It is during this time of year that the parable of the Sower from Matthew 13 comes to mind. Gardeners who have dealt with inhospitable conditions can relate especially well to this parable. Drought, invasive critters and thorny weeds often seem to conspire against growers' efforts. Yet when seeds fall on "good soil," the crop yield is abundant, up to a hundred times what was sown. Sometimes, people read that parable and emphasize the need for hearts to be receptive to God's Word. We want to be good soil where God's Word, love and faith can grow and prosper. That coming to pass would be wonderful.

I am not sure we need to focus on the planting conditions as much as the Sower. This one is extravagant with seeds. The seed goes everywhere. It does not always take root. It does not always blossom and produce. But that does not stop the Sower.

Pastor J. Ellsworth Kalas wrote, "Whenever we serve as witnesses to the faith, we must do so with all earnestness, because one doesn't know the season in which the soul currently abides. That uninterested, distracted or unresponsive person may be nearer the Kingdom than we, or they, realize. We dare not give up on anyone at any time – including ourselves."

May God nurture your faith in this growing season.



**ROOF PROJECT UPDATE** A special congregational meeting was held on Sunday, March 30<sup>th</sup> to discuss the upcoming roof project. The roof committee shared information and made a recommendation to hire Swita Metal Roofing for \$340,500 and Tri-State Gutters

for \$17,654. A motion was made and passed to approve \$350,000 for the roof and \$20,000 for the gutters, noting that this would cover any additional costs that might arise. At the end of the meeting, names were drawn for the "Raise the Roof Campaign" prizes. The winners were Jane Swiggum and Jane Nelson! Thanks to all who donated items for these prizes. \$356,852 has been raised for the roof and a gift that was given several years ago in the amount of \$15,417 has been designated to be used towards the cost of the gutters. We want to thank everyone who donated towards this large endeavor! Grace Lutheran is truly blessed!


